SATS Week

The SATs tests for Year 6 take place between the 8th and 12th May. It may be possible to arrange for them to take the test at a later time/date. If a Y6 pupil misses a test (eg. a Maths paper) they will not be awarded an overall score for that subject. The SATs for Year 2 will take place in the following week (15th to 19th May).
