#### **Snacks and Treats**



This year we have a number of pupils who have severe, potentially life-threatening, allergies to ingestion of, or contact with, even a small amount of wheat, nuts and some vegetables. At lunch times we are able to properly control and clean the areas in which these pupils eat. To further minimise the risk for these pupils, we ask that children bring fruit only as their break time snack.

We also kindly request that children do not bring in sweets or cakes for the class to celebrate their birthday. Thank you for supporting us in keeping all the children at St. Peter's as safe as possible.
