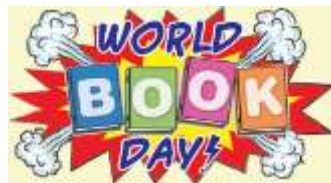
Details of how to book your appointment using this system will be sent out to you nearer the time of the Parent Meetings.
