School Dinners



After a meeting with Edsential, our school catering suppliers, we have decided to make some slight changes to our school meals. These changes will start after the half-term break with the children having a choice of a new Deli Bar option, as well as the normal hot meal. The Deli Bar will comprise of a chiller which will offer the choice of three fillings. Some of the choices on offer will be tuna, cheese, ham, chicken tikka, sliced turkey amongst others. There will be a choice of bread to cater for all tastes, again ranging from wraps, baguettes, soft white or wholemeal rolls, pittas etc. The children will then have the salad cart to help themselves to, along with a choice of drinks and desserts.

As a school, we feel these changes will be beneficial for the children as it will provide them with a greater variety of meal options compared to what they presently have. For those children who pay for their school meals the cost will remain at \pounds 2.40.
