How to log into Google Classroom

Type <u>www.google.com</u> into your web address bar.

Click on <u>SIGN IN</u> in the upper right hand corner of the browser window.



Type in your child's Google address. For children in F2-Y4, Your child's address follows the following format:

year of entry surname initial@stpeters-heswall.wirral.sch.uk

For example, a child who started St Peter's in 2016 would have the following address:


16cooksons@stpeters-heswall.wirral.sch.uk

For children in year 5/6: your child's address follows the following format:

Year BEFORE year of entry surname initial@stpetersheswall.wirral.sch.uk

Click 'Next', then enter your password.

Please note—year of entry corresponds with year of entry into F2. This applies to children who joined St Peter's later, for example a child who joined St Peter's in Y3 in September 2020 will have a username that starts with 17, NOT 20.



For children in F2-Y4. Your password is:

stpeters2020

The children in years 5 and 6 have set their own password.
