Wednesday – Come and Praise with Miss Collins

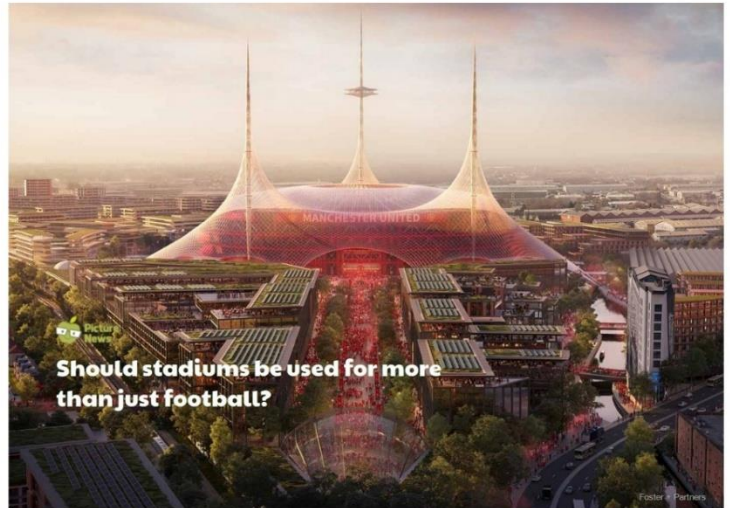
Thursday – KS2 Picture News. This looks at topical issues that are in the news. This was the most recent picture - Why not ask your child what they have been learning about?

Final Prayer


As a church school I always think it is good to end the newsletter with a prayer for the weekend. This is one was written by Erin Wood and Alice Owens.
