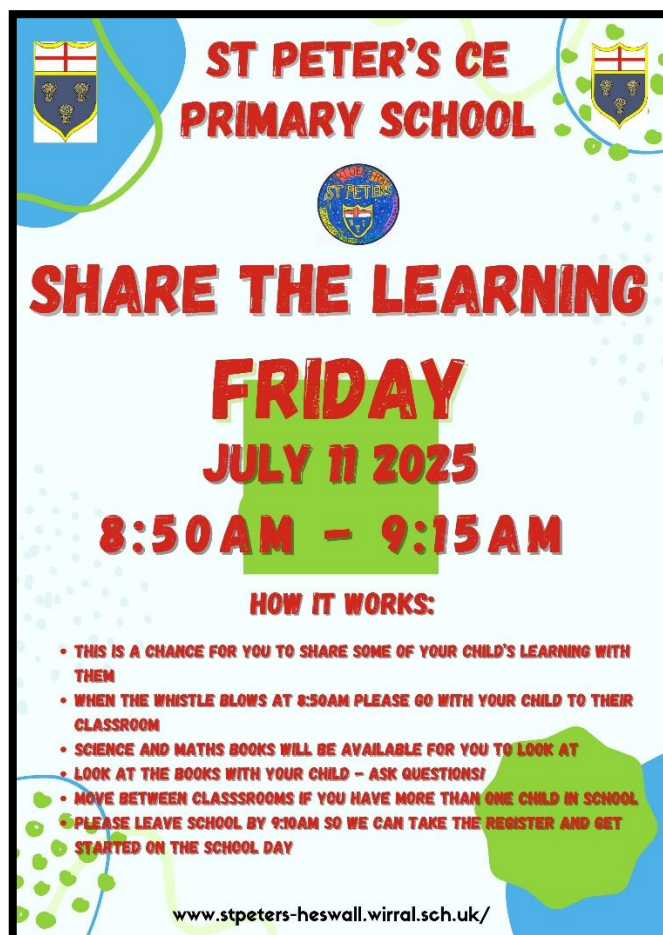
We have made provision for those Y6 children who will be in as well as any other children leaving at the end of the year.

Amen*


And this one was written by Miss Ward's class.
