These are the next class worship dates for you later this term:

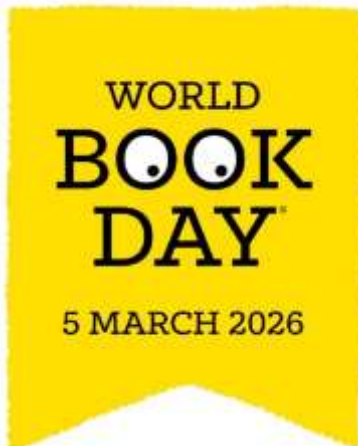
- Wednesday 11 March - Year 3/4FH

Thank you for the things I learned and the games I played.


I am thankful for:
