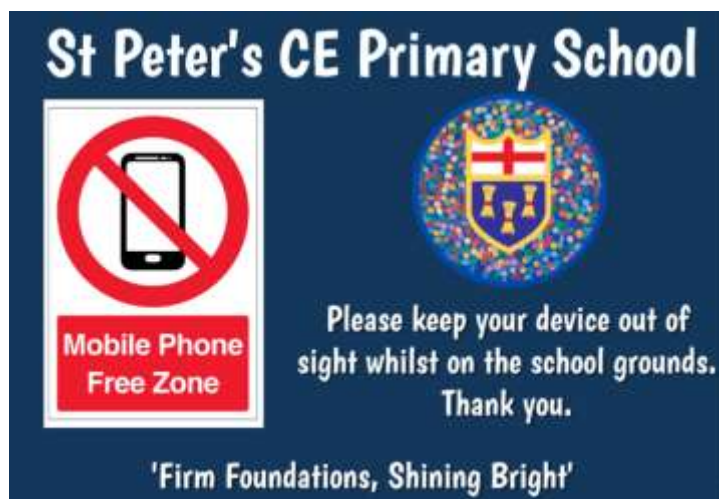

As we finish our second week of the summer term, we thank you for the bright sunshine, the green grass, and the fun we have with our friends.


Please help us to:
