Summer Holiday Work

Although it is the 6 weeks break for the children the school remains a really busy place, and this is the work that we have planned for the school building over the summer holidays:

- Replacement boiler and heating systems to the Year 5/6 classrooms
- Replacement of internal doors on the downstairs corridor (this is to ensure compliance with fire regulations)
- Re-decoration and replacement flooring of the dining room (in preparation for the launch of the 'St Peter's Bistro and Deli' school meal provision in September.
- Re-decoration of the upstairs corridor
