All the children have enjoyed joining in with the free sports clubs S4YC have run over the last week.

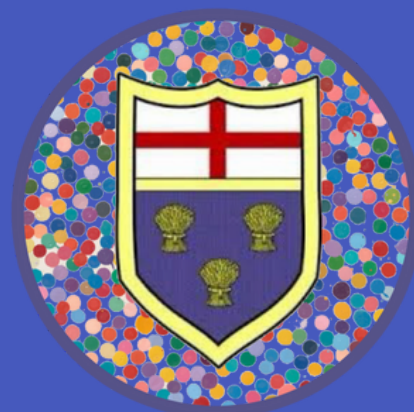
