SQUARES GAME

This game would work with ANY set of spellings that you have to learn.

SQUARES

The object of this game is to make more small squares than your partner:

- ⇒ Find an adult to play against you.
- \Rightarrow Use a 4x4 grid of dots like the one below, drawn in your book or on scrap paper.
- ⇒ Player one reads out a spelling from the list, <u>crosses it off</u> and player two must write it down.
- ⇒ If player 2 spells the word correctly, they connect two adjacent dots on the grid to make a line. If not, they do not do anything.
- \Rightarrow Player 2 then reads a word for the list for player 1 to spell.
- ⇒ Each player is trying to make more small squares on the grid than their partner—drawing the final line to complete a square makes it yours.
- \Rightarrow The winner is the person with most complete squares at the end of the game.
