Here are the double doors leading into our school.





When you arrive at school on your first day you will come to your classroom. This is at the back of our school.


Some children come up the side steps from the main playground.

Each week we spend some time in the computer suite.




Here we use the computers to help us learn new skills. We play games and complete activities on the computer.
